CHALLENGES ENCOUNTERED

The major challenges encountered in the discharge of my duties as a Quantity Surveyor are as follows:

- a. Delay in the release of budgetary allocations which seriously affects the execution of proposed projects.
- b. Bureaucratic bottlenecks associated with procurement processes like advertisement period, cost of advertisement, delayed decision making etc.
- c. Undue interference and corruption associated with the procurement process.
- d. Lack of qualified procurement professionals to handle procurement duties especially in the area of construction procurement management.
